2 Sam 7:1-22/ Rev 22:12-17

Why, perhaps, did God finally allow a house to be built for Himself (read all these and think hard...1 Sam 8:5; 2 Sam 7:2; Hebrews 8:1-6)?

1 Kings 11:9-13 says that Solomon, against all hope, was not the King in David's line that would bring an eternal Kingdom. Why was hope kept alive (Isaiah 55:3-4; Luke 1:30-33)?

Why was God's House for David far better than David's for God (John 2:19-22; Rev 22:16)?

David's house for God was affirmed only after the Covenant in which God's house for David was established. What is the parallel with us doing good works before and after salvation in Christ (Romans 3:28; Ephesians 2:10)? Why is the order of *faith in God's Promise, then works* so important?

What part in this house is for you and me (John 14:1-3)? Why is that such fantastic News (Ephesians 2:4-7)? What changes in your life have or ought to happen by the power of the Holy Spirit based on your amazing House from God?
